Learner Entry Requirements

Education: Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and have attained a Junior Certificate standard or equivalent.

The ability to correctly interpret and respond to written and verbal instruction is essential for both the assessment and tuition elements of this programme. Good manual dexterity skills, spatial aptitude, good hand/eye coordination and numeracy skills are also a requirement for this course.

Previous Experience: Category B driving experience.

Special Requirements: Irish learner permit Category C is essential.

Candidates: Must have access to good quality Broadband as some sections of the course such as CPC training will be delivered remotely.
